# **Walt Wise Memorial Police Pistol Match**

# **Registration & Check-in**

There are four types of matches that shooters may register to shoot in at the Walt Wise Match:

- Individual Matches (four 900 Matches)
- 2-Person Team Match
- 4-Person Team Match
- Commemorative Center Fire Revolver Match (38 Special, Iron Sights only)

### Check-in:

Pre-registered shooters should check-in and pick up their registration packets (has scorecards and brassard) at the Registration Window at the Stat House before their first relay begins.

#### **Match Registration Details:**

#### 1. <u>Individual Matches</u>

These are the fired Slow Fire, Police-L (same as the NRA National Match Course, except Police-L targets are used instead of NRA targets), Timed Fire, and Rapid Fire matches which make up the standard 900 match. See the Course of Fire for details.

You can register to shoot in Rim Fire, Center Fire, or both for these matches on Saturday or Sunday, or both.

- Saturday Rim Fire 900 Match (2 morning relays)
- Saturday Center Fire 900 Match (2 afternoon relays)
- Sunday Rim Fire 900 Match (2 morning relays)
- Sunday Center Fire 900 Match (2 afternoon relays)

The more 900 matches you shoot, the more money you save, and the more fun you have!

Registration may be done online by:

- Clicking the "Click Here for Registration Form" link near the top of the Walt Wise home page (this is our preferred method); then send a check or money order for payment by US Mail within 10 days of registering,
- US Mail (include check or money order), or
- Walk-on (pay by cash, check, or money order), pending availability of shooting positions.

<u>Note</u>: Be sure to check-in at the Stat House Registration Window prior to the start of your relay to pick up your registration packet, which includes a brassard and scorecards for all of your registered matches. All scorecards must be filled in with your name, competitor number, shooting position, etc.

#### 2. 2-Person Team Match

These matches are non-fired "paper matches" which use the aggregate of the Police-L match scores fired by each of the 2 team members to produce a 2-Person Team score.

2-Person Teams may be registered to shoot in Rim Fire, Center Fire, or both, on Saturday or Sunday, or both. Cost is \$5 per team member for each Team Match.

<u>Note</u>: Both team members must shoot the team match on the same day that the team is registered to shoot on. (E.g., 1 member can't shoot on Saturday, and the other member shoot on Sunday.)

Registration is done at the Stat House Registration Window by the Team Captain.

The Team Captain will pick up the appropriate scorecard (Rim Fire or Center Fire); fill out the form and turn it in with the \$10 fee.

The scorecard must have the names of the team members and their competitor number.

A team name is not required. A combination of the two team members' last names (e.g., Smith-Jones) will be used for tracking and reporting purposes.

<u>Note</u>: Team registration must be done in advance of the Rim Fire or Center Fire Police-L match being fired each day, as appropriate. It is best to get your team registration done early to ensure that you make the time cutoff.

Scores will be computed at the end of the 2nd Rim Fire match on Saturday and Sunday, and the 2nd Center Fire match on Saturday and Sunday, and the winners will be announced.

#### 3. 4-Person Team Match

These matches are non-fired "paper matches" which use the aggregate of the Police-L match scores fired by each of the 4 team members to produce a 4-Person Team score.

Bona fide 4-Person Teams may be registered to shoot in Rim Fire, Center Fire, or both. Cost is \$5 per team member for each team match.

The Rim Fire 4-Person Team Matches and the Center Fire 4-Person Team Matches may be fired on either Saturday or Sunday. <u>Note</u>: All 4 team members must shoot the team match on the same day that the team is registered to shoot on. (E.g., 2 members can't shoot on Saturday, and the other 2 shoot on Sunday.)

Registration is done at the Stat House Registration Window by the Team Captain. The Team Captain will pick up the appropriate team scorecard (Rim Fire or Center Fire); fill out the form and turn it in with the \$20 fee.

The scorecard must have a team name which can be anything you want (e.g., HH&A Gold); the names of the team members, their competitor number; and the day the match will be shot.

<u>Note</u>: Team registration must be done in advance of the Rim Fire or Center Fire Police-L match being fired on Saturday or on Sunday, as appropriate. It is best to get your team registration done early to ensure that you make the time cutoff.

Scores will be computed at the end of the 2nd Rim Fire match and the 2nd Center Fire match on Sunday, and the winners will be announced.

#### 4. Commemorative Revolver Match

This is a fired 30-shot Center Fire revolver match (.38 caliber, iron sights only). Cost is \$5 per shooter to register. Any safe 38 Special ammo is ok to use.

Registration is done online with the regular match registration or at the Stat House Registration Window. A Commemorative Revolver Match Scorecard will be given to each shooter who registers.

The revolver match is not a stand-alone match, and instead is incorporated into the regular afternoon Center Fire relays. The shooters will not be squadded. They will simply fill in on an empty shooting position on Center Fire relays 1 or 2, either day, to shoot the 30-round Police-L Course.

<u>Note</u>: The Commemorative Revolver Match registration must be done in advance of the Center Fire Police-L match being fired each day. It is best to get your registration done early to ensure that you make the time cutoff.

Scores will be computed at the end of the 2nd Center Fire match on Sunday, and the winners will be announced.
