



Centerfire 900 Safety Briefing

Safety on the range is paramount. We don't want anyone to get hurt, so please listen carefully.

Shooters must follow all safe gun handling rules, obey all range commands issued by the Range Safety Officer calling the line, and adhere to the following range safety procedures:

- Ear and eye protection must be used during the match.
- Do not bring any loaded guns to the range. Guns must be bagged or boxed until you are called to the firing line and are given permission to handle them.
- No guns will be loaded until you have been given the command to load.
- Any additional guns in your box must be unloaded, have empty chamber indicators (ECIs) in place, and be pointed downrange.
- When handling your gun on the firing line, always keep your muzzle pointed downrange toward the target.
- Keep your finger off the trigger until you are on target and ready to fire.
- When given the command to make the line safe, all guns must be unloaded and placed on the bench pointed downrange with actions open, magazines out, and ECIs inserted. If you don't have an ECI, we'll give you one.
- Do not go forward of the firing line until the line has been declared safe and you have been instructed to do so.
- Do not handle any firearm while anyone is down range.
- When the match is over, all guns must be unloaded and bagged or boxed.
- Turn any defective rounds over to range personnel. Do not deposit them in the trash cans.

Remember – safe and proper use of your firearm is your personal responsibility. Make it your top priority. Safety first, last, and always!
