### BB GUN

**BB Gun State Championship being held at HHA**: The entire clubhouse, indoor archery range and indoor pistol range will be closed starting on April 4th at 12:00 pm through April 5th till 8:00 pm. This event will bring over a total of 350 shooters, parents and relatives to HHA. The top 3 teams will qualify to attend the National Championship held in Rogers, Arkansas, Daisy's headquarters, held during the first week of July. BB Gun Results: Congrats to the BB Gun shooters!!!!

**Winter Championship** was held overFebruary 22nd/23rd. HHA entered 3 teams (16 shooters). The A team placed 3rd with a total score of 2283-49x. The B team placed 7th with a score of 2198-36x. The C team placed 10th with a score of 2102-26x. A total of 19 teams participated. A total of 104 shooters participated and HHA's shooters ranked from 2nd to 72nd. Not a bad start!!!!!!!

**NRA Sectional** was held over March 1st and 2nd. No test is taken for this match. This match is broken down into all teams and shooters, then broken down by ages of individuals on teams and as individuals. BB1 (age 13 to 15), BB2 (age 10 to 12), BB3 (age 8 and 9). Overall the A team placed 3rd, B team placed 7th and C team placed 9th out of 15 teams.

All shooting, Ayden Leed placed 3rd , 377-14x, Abigail Sowers placed 3rd in prone 97-7x, Giovanni Melendrez placed 3rd in standing 91-1x. HHA shooters ranked from 3rd to 69th out of 80 shooters.

BB1 category: HHA A team placed 3rd. Ayden Leed placed 3rd total shooting and 3rd in prone 97-5x. Giovanni Melendrez placed 3rd in standing.

BB2 category: B team placed 1st, 1691-31x and C team placed 3rd, 1615-17x. Abigail Sowers placed 2nd total shooting 365-12x, 1st place in prone 97-7x and 3rd place in sitting 92-3x. Tristan Shirk placed 3rd in prone, 95-4. Martin Birch placed 2nd in kneeling, 92-1. Grant Hess placed 3rd in kneeling, 91-5x

BB3 category: Simon Cooper placed 1st in prone, 93-3x.

#### **Competitive Air Rifle/Smallbore**

**Results**: 3P and 4P NRA sectionals held over March 1st and 2nd. 3P: Trevor Shirk placed 15th, score 474-8x, Laine Spahr placed 16th, score 458-1x 4P: Trevor Shirk placed 14th, score 340-10x. Great shooting for only having a few practices of smallbore.

The Competitive Junior Air Rifle & Smallbore Program is for youth ages 12 to 18 and runs throughout most of the year. Each season begins in September, but the youth can join anytime throughout the year. The program includes instruction on safe gun handling, the operation of both air rifles and smallbore rifles, and the fundamentals of Olympic Style three-position shooting. Practices are held from 6:15 to 8:30 p.m. on Mondays, with additional practices when necessary to prepare for competitions. The practices are held in the indoor pistol range. We also offer the opportunity to participate in clinics, leagues, and matches. Most matches are local, while some are out-of-state. # POLICE PISTOL COMBAT (PPC) MATCHES

It's almost that time of year again! HH&A's first PPC match of the 2025 season is coming up on Saturday, April 6th.

Our matches will be held monthly on the first Saturdays, from April through October, at PPC Range #2. Match dates are as follows:

- April 5 (Orientation & Training Day)
- May 3
- June 7
- July 5
- August 2
- September 6
- October 4

We will have 5 Gun Classes to shoot in and will run 5 relays per match date, as long as we have enough shooters. Cost is \$5 per relay.

Shoot as many relays as you like, pending availability of space. A minimum of 50% of fees taken in will be paid back as cash awards to winners using the Lewis Classification System. Each Gun Class will be handled separately for awards.

An end of season award raffle (gift cards and/or shooting accessories) will be drawn in November for those shooting more than 10 relays during the season.

Note: For the months of June-July-August, we plan to hold an 'early bird', sixth relay at 8:15 a.m. prior to the normal schedule beginning at 9:00 a.m. This will allow more flexibility for some shooters and an extra chance to add to your total relay count for the 'end of the season' drawing in November.

We run a cold range. Do not bring loaded guns to the range. Guns must remain unloaded and holstered or cased, except when under the direction of the range officer on the firing line, or when in a safe gun handling area.

Please come and join us for some fun. Bring a shooting friend with you. Our matches are open to the public. Beginners are welcome. It will be nice to see everyone again!

# SUMMER PISTOL LEAGUE

The HH&A 2025 Summer Pistol League (Bullseye) starts on April 23rd and runs from 6:30 - 8:30 p.m. every Wednesday evening through August 20th at our Outdoor Pistol Range.

We begin with a free practice night (2 relays) on Wednesday, April 16th, so the shooters can get their guns sighted in at 25 yards.

The one-time League Registration fee is \$10 for the 1st gun, and \$5 for a 2nd gun (optional). Match fees are \$1.00 per relay. Includes 3 targets: 1 Slow Fire, 1 Timed Fire, and 1 Rapid Fire.

Four relays are held each evening, weather permitting. Shoot as many as you like. Course of fire is the 30-shot National Match Course. All targets are shot with one hand at 25 yards using turning targets.

Any safe rimfire or centerfire semi-auto pistol or revolver (.32 to 45 caliber) may be used. Both iron sights and red dot optics are allowed. Bring your own stapler, staples, pasters/tape, pencil or pen, and empty chamber indicator (ECI). Ear and eye protection are mandatory. Brass catchers may be used.

All scoring will be done by shooters downrange. Pass scorecards right, score left. Scores will be recorded and averaged for the league by gun class, and cash awards will be given out at the end of the season using Lewis Class.

Note: Two-handed shooting will be allowed, but scores will not be eligible for awards.

### STRIKER-FIRE CHALLENGE MATCHES

HH&A will be holding six Striker-Fire Challenge combat pistol matches in 2025. No pre-registration is required. Just show up.

Range set-up and on-site registration starts at 8:00 a.m., match rules and safety briefing at 8:45 a.m., relay 1 at 9:00 a.m.

Five continuous relays will be run at our Police Pistol Combat Range #2 from 9:00 a.m. until around noon. Cost is \$10 per relay. Fifty rounds are required per relay fired (40 for Concealed Carry).

Four Gun Classes will be used:

- Stock (Iron Sights only)
- Open (Optics allowed)
- Stock Concealed Carry (Iron Sights Only, 3.7" barrel max, 2 mags needed per stage)
- Open Concealed Carry (Optics allowed), 3.7" barrel max, 2 mags needed per stage)

Shoot as many relays as you like (pending availability of space) in either or both Gun Classes. Cash awards for each Gun Class will be determined using the Lewis Classification System.

#### **Gun Classes:**

- Open Optic of choice allowed on pistol, multiple optics allowed on rifle
- Tac Ops Open sights only on pistol, one optic only allowed on rifle
- Armored Open rules apply to weapons, must wear a vest with ballistic plates
- PCC Pistol caliber carbine only, with no optic rules

Minimum caliber: 9mm for pistol, .223 for rifle

## WOODS WALK MATCH

HH&A will be holding a Woods Walk match on Sunday, May 18th at the Black Powder Woods Walk Range.

We allow three Gun Classes:

- Centerfire Handguns with Iron Sights
- Centerfire Handguns with Red Dots
- Rimfire Handguns with Iron Sights or Red Dots

Cost is \$10 per gun (limit 2 – must be in different gun classes). Cash awards will be determined by Gun Class, using the Lewis Classification System.

Fifty rounds of ammo are required for each gun fired. Any safe ammo is allowed.

Park at the Black Powder Clubhouse area. Check-in at the Classroom Trailer at the PPC Range.

Registration and squadding will run from 11:45 a.m. until 12:45 p.m. Mandatory safety and match procedure briefing starts at 12:45 p.m. Squads will proceed to the Woods Walk Range at 1 p.m.

An optional **Long Shot Contest** (starting at 100 yards) will be held after Woods Walk match. Cost is \$1. Winners in .22LR and in Centerfire Gun Classes will take all. Bring extra ammo.

# HH&A LEGISLATIVE AND REGULATORY OBSERVATIONS

The new legislative session is underway in Harrisburg. Typical anti-freedom bills that infringe on your 2nd amendment rights are being introduced by democrats. None of these bills have begun to move yet. The NRA Institute for Legislative Action (NRA-ILA) is your best source to follow actions at the federal level as well as state level issues that require immediate action. The websites of the Pennsylvania legislature as well as the NRA-ILA are below.

Pro-freedom bills at the state level include a constitutional right to carry firearms. In the House, HB 454 sponsored by Representative Bernstine has been referred to the House Judiciary Committee. In the senate, Senator Chris Dush is circulating a co-sponsor memo (precursor to a bill) to allow the same freedom. Both Bernstine and Dush are rock-solid 2A supporters. We are fortunate to have them in the General Assembly.
