

Walt Wise Memorial Police Pistol Match

Awards

Three types of awards will be given at the match:

- **Cash Awards** will go to winners of the Individual 900 Matches, the 2-Person Team Matches, the Commemorative Revolver Match, and the High Shooters in Categories and Special Categories (except High Junior who get a big trophy).
- **Trophies** will only go to the winners of the 4-Person Team Matches, and to the High Junior.
- Each registered competitor receives a commemorative **brassard**.

Cash Awards

1. Individual 900 Matches

Awards will be given to individual match winners in both .22 Rim Fire and in Center Fire gun classes, based on the Lewis Classification System.

Individual scores for each gun class will be sorted from high to low and then divided equally (as possible) into 3 Lewis Classes (A, B and C).

Within each Lewis Class (A, B and C), the top 10 places will get cash awards for each match (Matches #1 through #23).

The amount of each place award will be determined based on the number of shooters present and the amount of match fees taken in, less any expenses we have.

2. 2-Person Team Matches

Awards will be given to winners of the 2-Person .22 Rim Fire Team and 2-Person Center Fire Team matches both days, based on the Lewis Classification System.

This will be a non-fired “paper match” based on the Team’s aggregate Police-L scores (Police-L Match #7 or #18) for their appropriate gun class.

Team aggregate scores for each gun class will be sorted from high to low and then divided equally (as possible) into 3 Lewis Classes (A, B and C) if there are enough teams competing.

Within each Lewis Class (A, B and C), the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd Place winners will get cash awards, if there are enough shooters competing.

The number of Lewis Classes, winner places, and the amount of each award will be determined based on the number of shooters present and the amount of match fees taken in.

3. Commemorative Revolver Match

Awards will be given to winners of the Center Fire (.38 Special caliber, iron-sights only) Commemorative Revolver Match, based on the Lewis Classification System.

Individual fired scores (Police-L Match #7 or #18) for each registered Commemorative Revolver Match shooter will be sorted from high to low and then divided equally (as possible) into 3 Lewis Classes (A, B and C).

The 1st Place in each Lewis Class (A, B and C), will get a cash award, if there are enough shooters competing.

The number of Lewis Classes, winner places, and the amount of each award will be determined based on the number of shooters present and the amount of match fees taken in.

4. Categories and Special Categories

The top shooter (Match #23) in each of the following Categories and Special Categories (with the exception of the High Junior) will get a cash award.

They will also get special recognition by having their names posted in the Match Recap Report, which is sent out to all registered shooters with an email address on file, posted on the HH&A website, and published in the HH&A club newsletter.

Category

High Civilian
High Police
High Service

Special Category

High Woman
High Junior (Age 20 and under) – No cash. Trophy, Certificate of Achievement.
High Senior (Age 60-69)
High Grand Senior (Age 70-79)
High Super Senior (Age 80 and higher)

Trophies

1. Team Trophies

Trophies will be given to winners of the bona fide Rim Fire 4-Person Team Matches and the bona fide Center Fire 4-Person Team matches, based on the Lewis Classification System.

This will be a non-fired “paper matches” based on the Team’s aggregate Police-L scores (Police-L Match #7 or #18) for their appropriate gun class.

Team aggregate scores for each gun class will be sorted from high to low and then divided equally (as possible) into 3 Lewis Classes (A, B and C), if there are enough teams competing.

The Open Winner, and 1st and 2nd Place in each Lewis Class (A and B), will get a Team trophy, if there are enough shooters competing.

2. High Junior Trophy

A trophy and special recognition is traditionally given to the High Junior (Match #23) each year in order to encourage more junior shooters to participate in our matches.

Winners also get a Certificate of Achievement, and have their picture taken holding their trophy.

Brassard

Each year, we always give a commemorative brassard to all registered shooters during check-in at the registration window. The brassard displays the Walt Wise match theme and the year the match was held.
