Vice-President's Pen

It's Summer and the shooting hours are longer. Always be safe and responsible when using Firearms. Here are just some of the basic rules to keep in mind at all times at your club or anywhere that you might be shooting guns or handling firearms.

1. ALWAYS KEEP THE MUZZLE POINTED IN A SAFE DIRECTION

This is the most basic safety rule. If everyone handled a firearm so carefully that the muzzle never pointed at something they didn't intend to shoot, there would be virtually no firearms accidents. It's as simple as that, and it's up to all of us.

2. FIREARMS SHOULD BE UNLOADED WHEN NOT ACTUALLY IN USE

Firearms should be loaded only when you are in the field or on the target range or shooting area, ready to shoot. When not in use, firearms and ammunition should be secured in a safe place, separate from each other. It is your responsibility to prevent children and unauthorized adults from gaining access to firearms or ammunition.

3. DON'T RELY ON YOUR GUN'S "SAFETY"

Treat every gun as though it can fire at any time. The "safety" on any gun is a mechanical device which, like any such device, can become inoperable at the worst possible time.

- 4. BE SURE OF YOUR TARGET AND WHAT'S BEYOND IT
- 5. USE CORRECT AMMUNITION
- 6. IF YOUR GUN FAILS TO FIRE WHEN THE TRIG-GER IS SQUEEZED, HANDLE WITH CARE!
- 8. BE SURE THE BARREL IS CLEAR OF OBSTRUCTIONS BEFORE SHOOTING

POLICE PISTOL COMBAT (PPC) MATCHES

Our next PPC match will be held on Saturday, May 4th. No pre-registration is required. Just show up. Our matches are held monthly on the first Saturdays, through October, at PPC Range #2. Match dates are as follows:

- July 6
- August 3
- September 7
- October 5

We will have 5 Gun Classes to shoot in and will run 5 relays per match date, as long as we have enough shooters.

Cost is \$5 per relay. Shoot as many relays as you like, pending availability of space. A minimum of 50% of fees taken in will be paid back as cash awards to winners using the Lewis Classification System. Each Gun Class will be handled separately for awards.

We've added something new this year. An End of Season Award raffle (gift cards and/or shooting accessories) will be drawn in November for those shooting more than 10 relays during the season.

On match days, the security gate opens and range setup/registration will begin at 8:00 a.m. Safety briefing at 8:50 a.m. Hammer down at 9:00 a.m. We are usually done by noon.

We run a cold range. Do not bring loaded guns to the range. Guns must remain unloaded and holstered or cased, except when under the direction of the range officer on the firing line, or when in a safe gun handling area.

SUMMER PISTOL LEAGUE

The HH&A 2024 Summer Pistol League runs from 6:30 - 8:30 p.m. every Wednesday evening through August 21st at our Outdoor Pistol Range.

The one-time League Registration fee is \$10 for the 1st gun, and \$5 for a 2nd gun (optional).

Match fees are \$1.00 per relay. Includes 3 targets: 1 Slow Fire, 1 Timed Fire, and 1 Rapid Fire.

Four relays are held each evening, weather permitting. Shoot as many as you like. Course of fire is the 30-shot National Match Course. All targets are shot with one hand at 25 yards using turning targets.

Any safe rimfire or centerfire semi-auto pistol or revolver (.32 to 45 caliber) may be used. Both iron sights and red dot optics are allowed. Bring your own stapler, staples, pasters/tape, pencil or pen, and empty chamber indicator (ECI). Ear and eye protection are mandatory. Brass catchers may be used.

All scoring will be done by shooters downrange. Pass scorecards right, score left. Scores will be recorded and averaged for the league by gun class, and cash awards will be given out at the end of the season using Lewis Class.

Note: Two-handed shooting will be allowed, but scores will not be eligible for awards.

STRIKER-FIRE CHALLENGE MATCHES

HH&A will be holding five Striker-Fire Challenge combat pistol matches in 2024. No pre-registration is required. Just show up.

Range set-up and on-site registration starts at 8:00 a.m., match rules and safety briefing at 8:45 a.m., relay 1 at 9:00 a.m.

Five continuous relays will be run at our Police Pistol Combat Range #2 from 9:00 a.m. until around noon. Cost is \$10 per relay. Fifty rounds are required per relay fired (40 for Concealed Carry).

Three Gun Classes will be used: Stock (Iron Sights only), Open (Optics allowed) and Concealed Carry (Iron Sights Only, 3.7" barrel max, 2 mags needed per stage). Shoot as many relays as you like (pending availability of space), and in either or both Gun Classes. Cash awards for each Gun Class will be determined using the Lewis Classification System.

HH&A LEGISLATIVE & REGULATORY OBSERVATIONS

The US Supreme Court recently ruled in favor of the NRA in a landmark first-amendment case. In 2018, the state of New York began to 'black list' the NRA in financial matters, then use the power of the state to coerce banking and financial institutions to do the same. This case demonstrates the extent that those in power will go to attack your rights.

At the state level, the NRA ILA continues pushing back on a hostile state house that has passed a number of anti 2A bills. These bills are coming through the house judiciary committee. This is the price Pennsylvanians are paying since handing over the reign of the lower chamber to progressives. Make sure you vote this November. It will be below the horizon at that time, so plan to look towards the southeast after sunset to watch it rise into the sky. CLUB GROUNDS ARCHERY HUNT


